WHAT IS THE HUSKIE ATHLETIC FUND?


The HAF is the primary fundraising arm of NIU Athletics that supports over 400 student-athletes across 17 intercollegiate sports.

WHAT'S NEW?

2025 MEMBERSHIP ENHANCEMENTS

The 2025 membership year will look different with new enhancements the HAF has made to help establish and simplify our membership for our supporters. With these adjustments, members will know their exact giving level and what benefits they will receive. In order to gualify as a HAF member, donations must be made to the HAF unrestricted fund. This fund allows NIU Athletics to use these resources where needed most.

CHANGES TO BE AWARE OF:

- Our membership will run on the calendar year, January 1 - December 31.
- Payment plans will be offered during these months to make your donation more feasible.
- You will not need to purchase parking or hospitality passes separately as these benefits will be associated with your donation level.
- Membership cards will determine your hospitality access, see page 13 for more details.
- Parking is based off your donation amount, parking is allocated based off membership level first then priority points and HAF rank.
- Members must claim parking to receive a season Football parking pass, location is based off requests and membership levels.

- Black Membership Card allows free access to hospitality in the HAF Tent and Pub at no additional charge. (up to 4 people)
- Red Membership Card allows access to hospitality in the HAF Tent and Pub at \$10 per person.

MEMBER EXAMPLES

MEMBER 1

Member 1 wants to park in the West Lawn and wants free passes to the HAF Tent and Victor E. Pub:

Member 1 can join at the \$1,500 level to qualify for West Lawn parking and receive the Black member card with free access to our hospitality areas.

MEMBER 2

Member 2 wants passes to the HAF Tent:

Member 2 can join at the \$100 level and receive the Red member card for access to the HAF Tent at \$10 per person. With that donation, they will qualify for season parking in the C, L and Water Tower Lots.

MEMBER 3

Member 3 wants to park in the East Lawn and wants access to the Coaches Club:

Member 3 can join at the \$2,500 level to have access to the Coaches Club and with that donation, will qualify for East Lawn parking.

MEMBER 4

Member 4 wants two parking passes in the PS Lot and wants HAF Tent passes:

Member 4 can donate \$600 to receive the 2 parking passes and receive a Red member card for access to the HAF tent at \$10 per person or increase to the \$1,500 level for free access to our hospitality areas.




FACILITIES




GIVING OPPORTUNITIES

LEADERSHIP GIVING SOCIETY
